ABSTRACT: Saxophonists aspiring to perform significant classical repertoire will quickly discover the challenges of high register passages in the third and fourth registers. Many of the early saxophone concerti, namely those composed between 1930-1960, are the foundation of the saxophone's solo repertoire, and have guided composers and performers alike to explore the capabilities of the instrument in this regard.
